When you have completed some of the GWRRA rider educational offerings you will be able to make an assessment of the riding skill of our Chapter.

Now we are very fortunate as Ky - "C" has several people who are Rider Ed seminar presenters and Road Captain instructors. There is no need for traveling long distances to take advantage of these GWRRA programs. It just a matter of selecting a time and place for this to happen.

Something that all members can do is to procure a copy of the GWRRA's *"Team/Group Riding Manual"* that is used when this seminar is taught. There are several places on the internet if you just do a web search for GWRRA TEAM RIDING MANUAL. It has been around for several years and the last revision took place in 2005. However there is a version I like and use to teach by. This edition was prepared by the California District CA1 and has additional information in it. It can be found on the internet at <u>www.CA1S/CAgroupRidingManual</u>. Either one will work and I hope you will print out a copy and take the time to read it. In closing group riding takes special skills, training and practice. Chapters that do it well are impressive as they maneuver through traffic or out on the open highway. It looks "cool" when done properly but the most important thing is you are taking advantage of being safe and an alert "Team".


