While at the West Virginia Convention is when we found out that the government is going to raise the Ethanol level in gasoline from the E10% level to E15% level and they are to do it soon.

We did some research and found it to be true. What does this mean for us? It will eat away at all rubber components in all gasoline engines. We have found that Lucas Oil has a product that will bring the E10/E15 back to normal levels and also improve mileage. It is good for E10, E15, E20, & E85. Ride Tips form the CD

1. Just wanted to remind all of you that in this heat you will have to drink a lot of water or other liquids to stay hydrated. A rule of thumb is 15 oz. of water or energy drink every hour to replace the electrolytes and liquid you have lost.



2. Check your tire pressure before you ride . Air temperature can change the pressures in the tires. I filled my tires up at night when it was warm and in the morning I checked them and found if the cool morning they were low by 3 lbs. for to keep safe they should be checked before you go out and ride.
