While we still have some riding weather this season we must remember to ride prepared:

Remember when starting a ride in cooler temperatures do not do

aggressive riding until those tires have warmed up.

Remember the leaves that are on the roads; squirrels and chipmunks scurrying to get that last nut before winter really arrives.

Remember that deer are more prevalent and moving around due to pressures from hunting.

Remember to be extra careful in parking lots this time of year. During the holiday season they are hectic. 17% of all urban accidents take place in parking areas.

Remember to dress warmly and in layers when riding in cool weather. This allows you to remove in the middle of the day when it gets warmer and put it back on in the evening.

Know the warning signs of hypothermia; feeling cold, getting the chills and shallow breathing. Remember to stop more frequently to warm-up and get your circulation moving.

And finally remember to ride smart and prepared.
