Well it is time for a winter nap for most bikes. We should remember to put stable in the gas tank, put it up on the center stand and change the oil be for the long winter nap. It is also a great time to do some safety checks. Switches, lights including head lights turn signals, brake lights, dash lights. And all the led safety lighting that has been added so you can be seen better.

Switches why? Well it has come to my attention the they do stick when dirty. So if you are able get them to where you can clean them out so when ridding you wont have a problem. That includes the reverse, cruse control, 4 way flasher, and any other switches and controls that can get grime in them from the road and weather.

While still not being used please check your tire presser every week to make sure it is inflated to the proper level. This will help for long term storage over the winter. Don't forget your T-Clock before riding any time of the year keep safe.
