"Winging It" In the Rain

Spring has arrived and along with this long awaited season comes the rain. Most of us would rather not ride in these conditions but if you are a frequent rider, you will not be able to avoid these conditions completely. As we all know, rain can pop up at any time and when we least expect it.

When you ride in the rain, the pavement will be wet and slick. Motorcycles tires are designed to maintain traction in rainy weather. There are some additional riding techniques that can be implemented by the rider to ensure a safe ride on wet pavement. Some of these include:

Avoid any sudden moves
Accelerate smoothly
Turn smoothly
Use both brakes gradually when stopping
Reduce speed to increase stopping time needed
Maintain a larger space cushion in traffic to allow more time to react
Take turns slower to minimize the lean of your Goldwing
Avoid hydroplaning by following in the tire tracks of other vehicles
Watch your footage at stops as your feet will have decreased traction as well
If possible, avoid riding until 60 minutes after the onset of the storm

When the rainwater hits the pavement, it immediately mixes with the dirt and oil already on the pavement making it even more slippery. Warm pavement on highly traveled roads to lead to depressions and increase the risk of hydroplaning. Avoid those areas on the road that have an oil glisten to them as they will have decreased traction. Also avoid or practice extra caution on metal covers on the road, bridge gates, train tracks, painted lines or lane markings, leaves, wood on older bridges, and potholes.

Being alert and ever aware of the dangers of wet slippery pavement is the best safety precaution when riding your Goldwing in the rain. Ride safe!!

I also brought along my leather chaps, again just in case it got to hot I could remove my riding pants and go with the chaps. Maybe it sounds like I over packed for a short trip but if you have the room in your bags and trunk why not prepare for anything. My main riding gear can have each zip in liner removed as the weather changes and would allow me to stay comfortable and safe at the same time. I will tell you that on our return trip Saturday back to Lexington I rode in some of the strongest winds I have faced which made it very interesting the whole ride home.

Moral of the story is to ride safe and being comfortable in all types of weather and in your choices of riding gear. I'll close with a reminder to tell all your friends, neighbors, relatives and anyone else for that matter how much fun you are having with our Gold Wing group.
