December, such a festive month with Holiday shopping and Christmas parties going on. This is also the last month of the year and signals a time of snowy days and weather that is not very good for motorcycle riding. It also signals a time of year to do some the preventive maintenance on your bike while it sets in the garage.

Take some time to do a complete inspection of your bike from brake shoes and rotors to oil and filter changes and don't forget to drain and refresh your antifreeze if it is more than 3 years old. Do the little inspections like the condition of cables, wire connectors, headlight and taillight brightness. In some cases if you have a bad seal around any of your lights then dust and dirt can get in and cover the bulb and inside of the lenses to reduce the amount of light that gets out and reduce the visible brightness. Check your foot pegs for aging rubber and if they are split of cracked see if you can buy replacements. Most of the spare or replacement parts you might need are usually easier to get in the fall than in the spring when all bikers are looking for them.

Whatever your activity is with maintenance or waiting for those few good days when you can ride don't forget to invite a neighbor or friend to enjoy you bike time with you. If they ride but are not members of GWRRA then encourage them to check us out and show them some of our chapter newsletters (if you have copies) or just direct them to our web site and they can check out the pictures of all the good times we had this past year. Remember, more members then more fun!

Alice and I want to wish our GWRRA family a Very Merry Christmas and Happy and Healthy New Year! We are also looking forward to an even better 2016.
