Summer Winging

Summer is quickly approaching and I know we are all looking forward to more great rides on our Wings. We have already taken some fun rides and would have done more if this crazy Kentucky weather would cooperate. Now that we are anticipating summer and vacations, our Goldwing trips may be a bit longer than just a day ride. When we go for the day we just throw our legs over the bike and take off. If we are planning a longer trip, however, there is more planning and preparations we must take before we hit the pavement.

There are a few things that we must consider when we are taking a long (several days) trip on our Wing as opposed to a day ride. Before we take off we know that our bikes need a good physical but please don't forget that you need to be assured that you are physically prepared for the trip. A visit to your doctor to make sure everything is OK is advised. Is your body and stamina what it needs to be to ride safely for long distances?? Have your eyes been checked within the last year so that you are that assured that your vision is good? Are there any medications that you are taking that may impair your ability to ride safely? Go over your medications with your doctor to insure that you are taking them correctly and with the right dosage and make sure you pack enough to last you on your trip. I know all of these suggestions seem to be extreme but sometimes extremity is necessary for safety.

There are a few more reminders that should be noted before you venture out for a long journey on your Wing:

Give your motorcycle a physical too to make sure everything is in check.

Make sure you have stopped your mail or have someone to pick it up for you.

Notify credit card companies of your trip and possible charges from other states.

Turn your home alarm system on.

Make sure your insurance is up to date and that you have verification of coverage.

Check your route for detours or travel delays. Rescue Plus can help with this.

There are some states that require a license on your trailer (Florida) so make sure that you are prepared for the laws of the states you travel in.

May is National Motorcycle Safety Month so be extra cautious and practice all safety precautions at all times when riding your Goldwing.
