




## Hello Chapter C!!!

Several topics were discussed, and here are a few highlights:

- 1. Susan asked that she receive a copy of everyone's Newsletter.
- 2. The Co-Rider Course is now updated and has new information.
- 3. The Team Riding Course is now all new with new information, and with that, the Team Riding manual is obsolete. The Road Captain Course will be updated very soon and will also have new information.
- 4. GWRRA has not ever said that on-bike riding courses were not permitted. However, every Member is responsible for complying with their State's regulations regarding groups and gatherings.


